**Personal Description**

Dr. Stanley has been a professional clinical psychologist for 23 years and an on-line trader for 12 years. He has experience with trading stocks, options, futures. He became involved in investing and stock trading in the late 1970s while in college. His first involvement with on-line computer monitoring and research in stocks was in 1989. He began part-time day trading of stocks in 1997. He has completed several professional courses, including mentoring, in day trading, equity trading, option trading, and futures trading. He has extensive experience with trading all types of instruments. Dr. Stanley has taught, presented, and mentored nationally in the areas of clinical and health psychology, on-line trading, and trader psychology. He has supervised professional psychologists for licensure and mentored many on-line traders. He has special interest in trading psychology and the use of neurofeedback in human performance and trading.

**Goals for Mentoring**

Many students have found that working with a mentor is a major turning point in their trading and transitioning into a professional trader. They often report experiencing significant improvement in their trading following mentoring. This includes decreasing anxiety related to their trading and increased confidence as a trader. Mentoring permits personal attention to your needs in a private setting with another experienced trader. The actual mentoring is individually tailored to each student. This might include review of

DTI basic and advanced trading principles, greater understanding of the Roadmap, key and historical numbers, market timing, market framing, appropriate entries, targets, and stops, and trading psychology. Students also might desire to diversify their trading by learning more about equity and options trading during their mentoring. This might involved tape reading and spread strategies for different market situations. I like to speak to each student/trader prior to the mentoring for a brief interview to determine your needs during mentoring. I will help you to tailor your trading to fit your personality and life situation. Since I also was and continue to be a student and have participated in my own mentoring, I strongly suggest a two-day mentoring experience as your time and budget permit. I have learned that you never can pay enough for your education and that continuing education is key to success as a professional. Also, many traders will tell you from their own experiences that appropriate education and mentoring is more than worthwhile to avoid financial losses.
